HEREAFTER

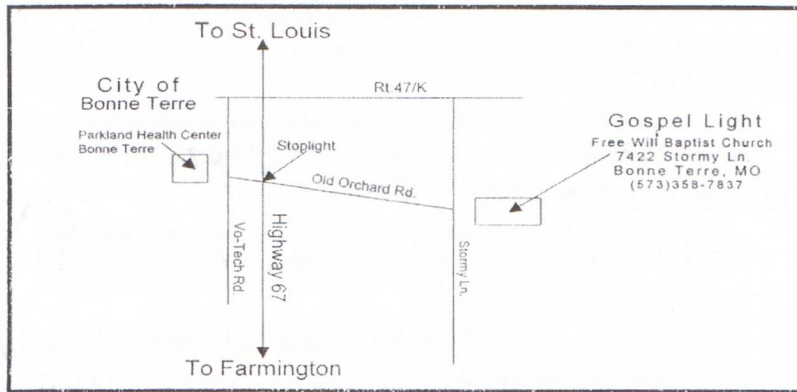
"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you
